The Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (RHRA) is an independent, not-for-profit corporation established under the Retirement Homes Act, 2010 by the Ontario Government, to administer the Act on behalf of the Government. The RHRA is responsible for:

- Informing the public and educating the retirement home sector and residents about the Act, regulations and role of the RHRA;
- Licensing retirement homes and maintaining a Public Register;
- Inspecting retirement homes using a risk-based approach, overseeing compliance and enforcing the Act for the protection of residents.

The vision of the RHRA is that all retirement home residents in Ontario ***Feel Right at Home***.

Reporting to the Board of Directors, the CEO/Registrar's chief responsibility is to provide strategic executive leadership of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority, including implementation and direction of the organization's infrastructure, systems, policies, programs and services in accordance with the *Retirement Homes Act, 2010* and regulations. The CEO/Registrar is responsible for developing and implementing the Board-authorized strategic plan, business plans following therefrom, discharging the oversight entailed in the CEO role, fulfilling the obligations of the Registrar role as prescribed in legislation, and managing relationships with the Provincial Government to ensure compliance with the Memorandum of Understanding and other agreements.

With substantive leadership experience in an executive capacity, the new CEO/Registrar will be an innovative leader with a track record of success. The CEO/Registrar sought will be a forward-facing leader with the ability to command the attention and respect of retirement home stakeholders as well as foster and cultivate key relationships with governmental partners. Inspired by and attuned to the mandate of RHRA, the professional required will be operationally sophisticated, have a bias for results, and will understand the dynamics of a regulatory body. The preferred candidate may originate from a regulatory environment, the broader public service, the health care sector, or an amalgam of these.
