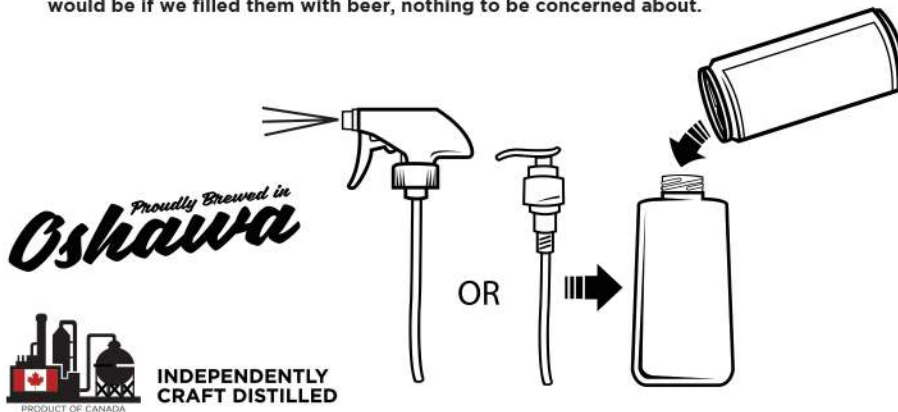
Transfer contents into "pump-style" container after opening.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

For the most effective use, transfer this topical solution or hand sanitizer into a spray-bottle or pump-style bottle.

- When using hand sanitizer, apply the product to the palm of one hand liberally and rub the product all over the surfaces of your hands until your hands are dry.
- Intended to be used as hand sanitizer but can be a surface cleaner as well.

Notice: Cans will be "squishy" as they have not been pressurized like they would be if we filled them with beer, nothing to be concerned about.

Use(s)

Hand Sanitizer to help reduce bacteria that potentially can cause disease. For use when soap and water are not available.

- on open skin wounds
