Program Delivery

- Self-paced online learning offered from June 7 to August 31, 2021
- 10 mini-courses including:
 - Introduction to Computers
 - Introduction to Windows
 - Introduction to Microsoft Word/ Word Processing
 - Introduction to the Internet
 - Searching the Internet
 - Using Email
 - Using Tablets
 - Using Smartphones
 - Using Applications
 - Using Social Media
- Receive an e-badge for each course completed or complete all 10 courses and receive a certificate of completion
- Participant learning supported through Fanshawe College virtual student volunteers

Program Participants

This program will accept 25 participants and targets supporting seniors from vulnerable populations. Seniors representing Indigenous communities, rural areas, newcomers and individuals with health challenges are encouraged to apply.
